Utah Gold Cup Rules 2021

1. Number of Games:

A. Each team will play a minimum of three (3) games. (If a team drops because of the virus, we will do our best to find another match)

2. Rules:

- Rules will be played under FIFA and USYSA adjustments for youth competition.
- USSF/USYSA/UYSA or other approved player passes will be required at all games.
- Rules regarding conduct of spectators, coaches and player will be in accordance with FIFA rules and regulations.
- Any player or coach given a red card will not be permitted to participate in the remainder
 of the game and the next scheduled game. The referee will be instructed to mark the
 check-- in documentation of the red carded player/coach.
- Ejections will be forwarded to the team's state association.
- Shin guards must be worn by each player.
- NO PROTEST WILL BE ALLOWED!

3. Substitution Rules:

Substitutions will follow UYSA league play rules.

The UYSA substitution policy can be found in our Bylaws and Policies --Section 6 Player Development, 6314 #Bb

Substitutions are:

- a. Subject to the referee's discretion, teams may make an unlimited number of substitutions during a game.
- b. Subject to the referee's discretion, substitutions may be made at the following times:
 - 1. The possessing team may substitute prior to its own throw--in:
 - 2. The non--possessing team may substitute prior to a throw--in by the possessing team if the possessing team is also making a substitution and the non--possessing team's substitutes are at the halfway line ready to enter the game;
 - 3. Either team may make substitutes at the following times:
 - 4. Prior to a goal kick by either team;
 - 5. After a goal by either team:
 - 6. After an injury to either team when the referee stops play; (d) At halftime;
 - 7. On a caution, only the cautioned player may be substituted if desired.

Substitutions shall be made in the following manner:

- The referee must be informed of and acknowledge a proposed substitution;
- A substitute must be standing at the halfway line prior to the substitution opportunity;
- A substitute must enter the field of play at the halfway line;
- The substituted player may exit the field of play anywhere;
- A substitute may not enter the field of play until the substituted player has exited the field of play, unless otherwise directed by the referee.


4. Regulation Time:

- U9-U10 ---- 25 minute halves, no overtime for regulation play.
- U11-U14 ---- 30 minute halves, no overtime for regulation play.
- U15-U!9 ---- 35 minute halves, no overtime for regulation play.
- **5. Quarter--Finals:** Same as regulation play. If tied at end of regulation play, go directly to penalty kicks per FIFA rules.
- **6. Semi--Finals:** Same as regulation play. If tied at end of regulation play, go directly to penalty kicks per FIFA rules.

7. Finals:

• U9-U19 Same as regulation. If tied at end of regulation play, 2 five minute overtime periods; if still tied, penalty kicks per FIFA rules.

8. Scoring Tabulation will be kept as follows:



9. Scoring System to determine bracket winner:

If necessary the following tie breaker rules will be used to determine the order of team advancement to the quarter-finals or semi-final round.

This tie--breaking procedure shall be used if necessary to determine 1st and 2nd place standing within the bracket. If more than two (2) teams are tied at the end of the preliminary round, the tiebreaker criteria listed will be used in the order shown, beginning at #2 to advance one team. The remaining teams will then be compared, beginning again with criteria #2 to determine the ultimate placement. (If all 3 teams are tied and have all beaten each other then #1 Head to Head is tossed to determine the placement of all 3 teams)

- 1. Head to head results.
- 2. Cumulative goal differential between goals scored and goals allowed in all games played within the team's flight. Maximum difference allowed is three (3) goals per game.
- 3. Fewest goals allowed in all games played within the team's bracket.
- 4. Most goals scored (up to 3 per game)
- 5. Most Shutouts
- 6. If a tie still exists, the team with the most shut-outs will be determined the winner.
- 7. Finally, penalty kicks per FIFA rules will be used if a tie still exists between the two teams, to determine the winner.

10. Awards:

- Individual awards for 1st and 2nd place in all divisions.
- Directly following championship game, awards will be made at the "Information Area".

ROSTER REQUIREMENTS

- Utah teams must create an Official UYSA Tournament Roster with player photos that
 lists every player, including guest players and tournament only players, and coach. Six
 copies of the Official Tournament Roster must be presented at tournament check-in no
 later than two hours before the first scheduled game. Rosters will be frozen when the
 Official Tournament Roster is presented at check-in. (See below for step-by-step
 instructions for how to create a Tournament Roster in Affinity.)
- Out of state teams must present one copy of an official player roster AND laminated photo player cards for each player and coach at tournament check-in.
- Guest Players: (See the chart for guest player limits) For every guest player on the roster

(Utah teams and out of state teams), the following forms must be completed with all required signatures and submitted at tournament check-in:

- 1. A state approved registration form with consent for medical treatment
- UYSA Specialty Player Action Form (Guest Player section completed). (The Specialty Player Action form is available at https://usys-assets.aeadmin.com/assets/985/15/specialty_player_action_2011-2.pdf)
- 3. Out of state teams must also present a laminated photo player cards for each guest player.
- **Tournament Only Players:** Laminated UYSA player cards are required for tournament only players, and must be presented at tournament check-in.
- Registered Coaches: IT IS STRONGLY ADVISED THAT EVERY TEAM HAVE MORE THAN ONE LICENSED, REGISTERED COACH ON THEIR TEAM ROSTER. Any team playing a game without an officially rostered coach present will forfeit that game.
- Multi-Rostering of Players is not allowed. If a player is found to have played on more than one team, all games the player participated in will be forfeited.
- **Medical Release Documents:** Team managers must have all player medical release documents in their possession at each game.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

 Tournament Check-In: ONLINE CHECK IN ONLY! Please all copies of all materials at all games.

Utah teams:

- 6 copies of the Official Tournament Roster (see instructions to create a Tournament Roster in Affinity)
- 2. Laminated UYSA player cards for any tournament only players
- 3. Specialty Player Action Forms for all guest players (properly completed and signed by parent, player, and coaches)

The Official Tournament Roster, Specialty Player Action Forms, and or laminated photo player cards for tournament only players will be reviewed for compliance and stamped "Approved." The laminated photo player cards for tournament only players will be stickered and returned to the person checking in the team. One copy of the Official Tournament Roster and all Specialty Player Action forms will be filled at tournament headquarters; the other 5 copies of the Official

Tournament Roster will be returned to the person checking in the team. One copy of the approved Official Tournament Roster must be presented before every game to the game officials.

Out of state teams:

- 1. 1 copy of your official team roster from your club or league registrar
- 2. Laminated photo player cards
- 3. Specialty Player Action Forms for all guest players

The Tournament roster, laminated photo player cards, and Specialty Player Action Forms for guest players will be reviewed for compliance. The laminated photo player cards will be stickered and returned to the person checking in the team.

The official team roster and all Specialty Player Action forms will be filed at tournament headquarters. The laminated photo player cards must be presented before every game to the game officials.

11. Home Team:

A. Home team will wear dark uniform, Away will wear light.

- B. Home team will change uniform in case of a conflicting color as determined by the center referee.
- C. Home team may choose which sideline it desires.
- D. Home team may choose which end of the sideline it desires.
- E. Teams will all sit on one side of the field and spectators on the other

Water Break Rule:

If the temperature is over 90 F the ref will be allowed to implement a water break for in which each team will be allowed to get water during a 1 minute and 30 second break.

- The clock will continue to run during the water break.
- Coaches are allowed to take the minute to coach their players.
- The ref has the right to caution/warn a coach if they take longer than the allotted time.

AFFINITY TOURNAMENT ROSTER INSTRUCTIONS

HOW TO CREATE AN OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT ROSTER IN UYSA/AFFINITY:

- 1. Go to <u>www.utahyouthsoccer.net</u>.
- 2. Login in under Member Login which is located on the top right hand of the UYSA homepage.
- 3. You will now be on the "My Account" page. Click the Teams tab, click on the "Team Info" link to the right of the team name.
- 4. Click on the Tournament Roster tab, and then "Create New Request".
- 5. Fill out tournament information with the following:

a. Tournament Name: Utah Gold Cup

b. Federation: UYSA

c. Event Start Date: September 2nd, 2021 End Date: September 6th, 2021

d. City: Draper State: Utah Postal Code: 84097

6. Click on "Save".

- 7. Next, click on Roster below the Tournament Roster tab. You can delete administrators and players by clicking on the red X next the admin/player's name. To add a guest player click the Add Player/Admin Inside Org at the bottom right hand side of the screen. Choose the Roster Role from the drop down and enter the ID Number and click "Save & Continue." Jersey numbers can also be added along with player positions on the roster page. Always click "Save & Continue" after each addition or change.
- 8. Click "Save & Continue." Make sure at the upper right next to Status, it says, "Accepted."
- 9. If you add a guest player or a tournament player the status will say borrowed. If the player is a guest player, you must submit a completed Specialty Action Form with their coach's signature at the tournament check in. If this player is a tournament only player the tournament only card must be submitted at check in. (Specialty Action Form)
- 10. Once you've made all the roster changes/additions, click on "Submit and Review" on the purple line.
- 11. Click on "Submit" and click on the "Submit Application" button.
- 12. Click on the "Review" Button, and select "Print Photo Roster" button to print photo roster.
- 13. A photo roster will be created with pictures. On the "Select a format" pull down menu at the top, select PDF, then click on "Export."
- 14. A formatted photo roster is now on your screen and can be printed using your print driver.

To make changes to your tournament roster:

- 1. Login in to your UYSA account.
- 2. Click the Teams tab, then the "Team Info" link to the right of the team name.
- 3. Click on the Tournament Roster tab, and then under "Utah Gold Cup 2021," click the "Edit Application" button.
- 4. Click Roster below the Tournament Roster tab. From this page, you can make any necessary roster changes.
- 5. Click "Save & Continue."
- 6. Follow steps 12-14 above to print the photo roster.

TOURNAMENT REFUND/CANCELLATION POLICY

After a team is accepted, then no refunds will be issued, exceptions as follows:

> CANNOT FORM BRACKET FOR YOUR TEAM

If the tournament cannot provide a bracket for your team to participate, then you will receive a full refund. An example of this would be if the tournament does not have enough teams to fill your age group.

> WEATHER

In the event that inclement weather forces the cancellation of all or part of the tournament, teams will have the option to receive a credit or cash refund of a percentage of their paid entry fee. This credit is to be used in future SMC soccer tournaments (within one year), and will be given in the following increments:

- No games played = 75% credit or 50% cash refund
- One game played = 50% credit or 25 % cash refund
- Two games played = 25% credit only

> COVID-19

In the event that Covid-19 forces the cancellation of the tournament, teams will have the option to receive a credit or cash refund of a percentage of their paid entry fee. This credit is to be used in future SMC soccer tournaments (within one year), and will be given in the following increments:

100% credit or 75% cash refund

In the event that your team has to withdraw from the event due to Covid-19, teams will receive the following:

Refund of your entry fee paid minus \$50 administration fee

> NOT RECEIVING GUARANTEED 3 GAMES

In the event that your team does not receive 3 games due to a team forfeiting or dropping out, teams will receive the following:

- One game played = 75% credit or 50% cash refund
- Two games played = 50% credit or 25% cash refund

*Please note that if one of your games is cancelled however you still play 3 games, then no refund/credit will be given.

If the event is cancelled due to any other reasons not stated above, the tournament committee will meet to go over all expenses to determine the amount of refund/credit that will be given to teams.
