People attending the U17 Boys and U18 Girls finals must purchase a \$12 ticket to enter the stadium, through the ticket link above. In place of a parking fee at the Cotton Bowl, we do ask that people donate either a couple of unopened canned goods or an unopened new toy for Christmas as donations. Donations can be left at Gate K when entering the stadium. Please use the map above that shows how to enter the fairgrounds and where to park (Lot 12AA). Concessions and restrooms will be available and patron seating will be sections 5, 6, and 7.

Only the players and their coaches (3 max) will be allowed through security free and on the field. I ask that teams arrive an hour before game time and are ready to enter Gate K at the times mentioned above. BE ON TIME. Teams still must bring a printed approved roster. Locker rooms will not be available for these finals due to them being used for multiple events over the weekend. Teams may use the concourse at the end of the tunnel to get ready. The same tournament rules will apply to these finals. Game balls will be provided. The award ceremony will be held on the concourse after your game is done behind the south goal. People will be allowed to come down to take pictures here. Tournament apparel will not be sold at the Cotton Bowl. Lastly, please respect the stadium property and clean up your team bench areas when done, so we may continue to do this in the future.
